For example, there are enclosed compost bins as well as open compost bins. Consequently, a wooden compost bin made of untreated wood will not last very long and you will soon need to replace it.

If you have more space available to you then you can choose a larger compost bin design. For the most part, the type of material that you use to create a compost bin is not relevant. There are some neighborhoods that will not even allow open compost bins, so be sure to check on your neighborhood regulations when choosing a compost bin design. If you do not have a lot of space then a smaller compost bin will be best.
